Thank you for participating in the Child Development Programme's (CDP) screening for 2 year olds. We hope that it was a worthwhile experience for you as a parent and for your child. As I explained to you, the CDP screening includes items that look at problem-solving ability, language skills and motor development.

Based on the developmental screening, there appear to be no concerns for Evangeline regarding problem-solving ability, language skills, motor skills or parenting issues. Your child appears to be making good developmental progress in all areas covered at the screening. We encourage you to share this information with your child's health care provider if you so desire.

It should be noted that the screening does not predict how well your child will do later in school. It is not designed to diagnose conditions such as learning disability, language disorder, or emotional disturbance, and it should never substitute for a full assessment or physical examination.

You will continue to receive developmental booklets, which we hope you will find helpful. We encourage you to use our children's Toy/Book library as well as our Parent Library. CDP provides support, information and service to families in Bermuda and their children from birth to 4 years of age should you have questions or concerns in the future.
